In the fall of 2005, the Wisconsin Division of Motor Vehicles (DMV) will begin issuing new style cards.

The new license was designed to meet colors, formats and security features approved by the American Association of Motor Vehicle Administrators. The card contains three levels of security features: overt, covert and forensic. Cards will be covered with a special security overlay to prevent tampering and alterations.

The capture of digital images will enable the DMV to compare images of customers on file with newly captured images and reduce the potential of identity theft.

Increased font size of vital information (license number, date of birth, and name) make the new card easier to read, even under adverse conditions.

New Colors

Driver licenses have a pink hue and identification cards have a green hue for easy distinction. The new image background color is a light blue. Because the cards are phased in over an 8 year period, images used from the previous system will contain a grey image background color. Special codes provide a quick reference to origin of issuance.

Persons can continue to designate their desire to be an organ / tissue donor by signing the anatomical gift statement. Persons checking "yes" to being an organ / tissue donor on their application will receive a card with the organ donor dot inserted by the system.

Under age 18 and under 21 easily identifiable.

Persons under the age of 21 will receive a card in a vertical format. White on red reverse printing indicates under age 21. Black on yellow print indicates under age 18. Date of birth is printed in red. A special UV security feature protects the card from alterations.

Back of card contains 1-D and 2-D bar code.

The 2-D bar code makes the card machine readable containing only the information printed on the front of the card.



A new 1-D bar code provides an inventory control registration number that ties a specific card to a customer preventing the use of unauthorized cards to produce fraudulent licenses.

Classes, endorsements, and restrictions are printed out on the back of every card.

A fee receipt is provided on the upper left corner.

A unique product number is assigned to the upper right corner for each product type and customer.
